



## **Qualifications for Bareboat Charter**

Minimum requirements to qualify as a Bareboat Charter Skipper:

American Sailing Association: ASA 104, Bareboat Cruising Certificate. Or:

Bareboat cruising certification from another National or International body which shows you:

- 1) Are able to skipper a sloop-rigged, auxiliary powered keel boat of approximately 30 to 45 feet in length during a multi-day cruise upon inland or coastal waters in moderate to heavy wind (up to 30 knots) and sea conditions.
- 2) With knowledge of:
  - a. Provisioning, galley operations
  - b. Boat systems
  - c. Auxiliary engine operation
  - d. Routine maintenance procedures
  - e. Advanced sail trim
  - f. Basic coastal navigation including basic chart plotting
  - g. GPS and Chart Plotter Operation
  - h. Proper anchor and mooring
  - i. Docking single screw under powered auxiliary sailboat
  - j. Health & safety issues
  - k. Emergency operations
  - l. Weather interpretation
  - m. Dinghy/tender towing and operation

Or able to demonstrate through experience the above knowledge and skills.
